September F5J Contest Report Lenny Keer – CD

The final F5J electric soaring contest for the year was held on September 14th. Participation was less than hoped for, with only 3 entries in SP400 class and 2 in Open class. Gary and Cameron Hill came from Nebraska to fly in our event and had a blast. Look for them to be back again.

With such a small group, we were able to run at a relaxed pace, and still get five rounds in by 2:00. In SP400, Gary Hill finished in third place with his Omega-E (Northeast Sailplanes), Steve Scofken took second flying his Filip-E (Hobby Lobby), and Lenny Keer won flying a Mirage HLG converted to electric.

Gary hill was second in Open class, flying a SP600 powered Ellipsoid (Espirit Models) and Shannon Bingham won with his new Hacker powered Electric Escape (Skip Miller).

You'll find the tabulation of scores for this year's contests listed on the web page. Note that the ESWC F5J contest in Phoenix is held in October and can be counted as a national level F5J score. Yearly totals are based on the best three contests.

September HLContest Report Shannon Bingham – CD

The September Hand Launch Contest was held Saturday the 21st with four contestants in attendance. It has already cooled off, but by around 10:30, the thermals were poping. Given the light turnout and problem with having enough people to time and record, we used a "1,2,3 launch" format for 18 rounds. This got all four models into the air during each round instead of 2 each. This is a great way to run a small handlaunch contest, especially if you have an extra person to watch the landing order and record which we did (Thanks John!). A new member, Gary Scrip from Vail, joined Jim and Joseph Newcomb and myself for the contest. The conditions were great for the 18 rounds with lots of 2 minute maxes which we declared draws and scored equally if we were skyed out. Off-field landings were scored as "0". Everybody tip launched. Jim and Joseph both flew Raptors. I flew an Encore. Gary flew the nice balsa / glass molded wing handlaunch made by NSP like the one Lenny was flying earlier in the year - I don't know the name of it, but it flew well and Gary launched it nicely even as a new discus launcher - way to go, Gary. Gary drove down from Vail for the contest and I was very glad that we were able to make the trip worth his trip. We flew the first 12 rounds in about 40 minutes then broke for lunch and charging. Flew the last six after lunch. We considered adding another 6 rounds, but the wind picked up dramatically and we could tell the thermals were being sheared off down low and we were looking at a launch contest, so we stuck with the 18 rounds declared. 
