# **August Open Contest Bob Johnston CD**

When I walked ouot my door at 7:00AM and looked up at the sky I thought to myself, this is going to be a beautiful day! About 1/2 way to the field, near the Platte RIver, it became cloudy - (foggy maybe) and was still overcast as I parked at th sod farm. Optimism prevailed and the clouds burned off quickly. The winches were set up to the north as we readied for the first launch. The flight groups were organized and we got started. This is the first contest I ever CD'd and was grateful to Don Ingram for his help as Co-CD. Tony O'Hara and Clarence DollMeyer did a great job of keeping score. I thought we would be on our own for scoring, but lo and behold, Jim MOnaco WAS there. I'm not sure we could run a contest without him. In retrospect I can't remember a smoother running contest. We never had to move the winches, the sprinklers were never an issue, there were no line breaks, and shaggers and pilots we in position and little time was lost to delays! A flight round of four groups averaged 1 hour each with 5 rounds being flown, plus a 15 minute flyoff for the top 6 finishers to claim unofficial "Top Dawg" bragging rights. (See results below).

Pop-off save of the day goes to Jack Zika. He popped off really early on launch (about 75ft) and wend downwind to the road and caught a light thermal with his lightweight AVA, climbed out, and worked and fought to get his time for the round. Nice job Jack!!

Rich O'Connell had a great low-level save also. A call was heard something like "Help - Mr. Wizard - I want to come home!" Skip was standing nearby and offered his assistance. Rich then dug his heels in and scratched for deveral minutesbefore he worked up to a comfortable height. He also made his time.

Bob Lewan had the save that almost was! He worked and worked until his lift finally vaporized and as most often the case with low level saves, It just didn't happen. The clock struck midnight on this Cinderella story and Bob had to beat a hasty retreat for home a bit shy of the 10 minute horn. All who observed his effort scored Bob high in the "Dang - I almost had it" category.

In the primary rounds Mark Howard won the contest, followed by Rich O'Connell who put together 5 great rounds. Tom Gressman was third and Dr. Dan was  $4^{th}$  with Skip placing  $5^{th}$ .

In Sportsman class - Danny Dermer edged out new member Brad Riegler for top honors. Go going guys.

The flyoff was very tight with Skip Miller and Dr. Dan tieing for first place. Mark Howard came in 3<sup>rd</sup>, Tom Gressman 4<sup>th</sup>, Rich O'Connell 5<sup>th</sup> and Phil Jones was a DNF (did not finish).
